

**Region 5 High School & Middle School String Orchestra Auditions**  
**Saturday, November 7, 2015**  
**Young JH**

Students:

Use the main entrance on the east side of the building facing Woodside Drive. Signs will direct you to the sign-in tables and warm-up areas. Music stands will not be provided so you may want to bring your own. **All Violins, High School Violas, Junior High Cellos, and Junior High Basses** will need to arrive at Young Junior High School by **8:15** am. Middle School Viola, HS Cello and HS Bass players do not sign in until **9:30** am.

When you sign in you will receive your audition number. That is the order in which you must audition. Do not share this information with ANYONE, especially your director. Announcements to line up for auditions will be made throughout the day in your warm up room. Please listen for your audition number and go to the room with your group. If you miss your audition, you will not be allowed to go back.

Cuts will be posted in your warm up area by 8:30am for ALL violins, HS violas, JH Cellos, and JH Basses and 9:30am for JH viola, HS cello and HS bass. Be sure to mark your music with these cuts. You must audition in the order listed.

Once you enter the room to audition, **do not talk under any circumstances**, even to the monitor. This can lead to disqualification. After the room monitor announces your number and leaves the room, begin playing. Do not wait for the judges to tell you to begin (they will not talk to you). After you have played, you will collect your music and leave the room. If you have a question, please go out of the room and talk to the monitor.

Audition results will be posted approximately 30-45 minutes after the last performer is finished. Violin results will be posted approximately 1 hour after the last violinist finishes. You do not have to stay all day to wait for results.

**HS AND MS Violin:** You will be performing in TWO separate rooms. Once you have signed in, find the cuts for each of the two rooms that you are performing in. You will play in **Room 1** first and then go directly to **ROOM 2**.

All violin rooms should have someone playing at all times, and all violinists need to make sure they play in each room. The monitors will help you find the right rooms in the right order. Once you have played in all violin rooms you are done for the day.

Concessions will be sold in the cafeteria, but all food and drink is to remain in the **cafeteria only**. Please be respectful of the facility at Young JH.
